

Conditions of Entry

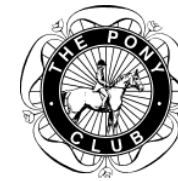
1. The organiser of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.
2. Neither the organisers nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident or injury to riders, horses, spectators or other person or property whatsoever.
3. Ruling date is the date of show.
4. Body protectors and Medical Armbands are compulsory for Pony Club members and recommended for other competitors.
5. All competitors must wear hats complying with **BSI Kitemark** (the EN 1384:1997, the BSEN 1384:1997 or the PAS 015:1998 standards), **or the brown Snell** label and number (the Snell E2001 standard) **or the red SAI Global Australian standard** AS/NZS 3838-1998 or AS/NZS 3838-2003 They must be worn with the chin strap correctly fastened at all times when mounted.
6. In the event of the Hunter trials being cancelled a percentage of the entry money may be retained.
7. No Horse or Pony may compete in more than two classes, except if accompanying a younger member in Class 1
8. Competitors in Class 1 & 2 may not compete in the Novice or Open Classes unless accompanying a younger member in Class 1
9. A practice fence will be provided. Any competitor jumping any other fence on the field or course, except when competing will be disqualified for the rest of the day.
10. No outside assistance is permitted.
11. The judge's decision is final.
12. Late entries consider as post 6pm Monday 8th April 2013.

The course will be open for walking on Saturday 13th April from 2pm – 7pm
